Are you Tuł, Cheops, or Rameses ?

One noticeable difference between King Tut and many other Pharaohs of Ancient Egypt was that he had to be discovered. He buried himself so thoroughly that it took the world three thousand years to unearth him.

He did not possess the well-developed ability for telling about himself as did one Cheops, who built an everlasting monument to his greatness in the way of a pyramid weighing about six million tons and hig enough to cover several city squares. Seventy-five other rulers of Egypt also built pyramids of various sizes as evidence of their appreciation of publicity.

Rameses II was called "the Great," and he believed in letting everybody know about it. He was the originator of spectacular advertising. The results of his activities may be found all over Egypt emblazoned on imperishable stone. He left his mark on everything in Egypt except the shifting sands. He carved his likeness on the eternal cliffs of the Nile, or framed them between the solidest temples. He blazoned his story upon the walls of giant pylons that everyone might look and read and marvel and applaud.

His annual advertising appropriation would make our modern efforts look very insignificant indeed. His advertisements are still so numerous and conspicuous as to make the modern traveller in Egypt think that Rameses was not only the greatest but the only king that Egypt ever had.

This noble advertiser of antiquity certainly placed his name on the map. What Rameses II would have done in the way of advertising if he had at his disposal the telephone directories of the world is a question for feats of imagination.

The period in which he worked knew only the slow and toilsome method of sculpture, which by the way, proved of greater advertising value to posterity than to contemporaries, but with the use of photo-engravings and printing presses he could have had a million times greater results from his effort and would have seen these results in his own lifetime
