

to the Rendezvous where Brigades and Divisional Units will form up.

The position of the Rendezvous of each Brigade and Unit of Divisional Troops will be indicated to the leading Troops of the Formation, etc. by the General Staff; subsequent bodies of Troops being directed by guides furnished from those who have already arrived.

Attention is drawn to the typed "Tracing" Notes - Naval and Military Operations" recently issued - particularly to the following:-

- (a) An Officer (for preference) or Senior N.C.O. to be placed - definitely in (military) charge of each boat. The Officer to be in the bows and give necessary orders.
- (b) Equipment to be fastened up just before beaching.
- (c) On beaching, all remain seated until the Naval Officer gives orders. The Military Officer in Command then jumps out immediately after the man (naval) in the bows. He forms up his boatload at the Forming-up Place facing inland, and the Troops then, if under fire, make for the nearest cover.
