

OTHER RANKS - SICK AND WOUNDED

Arms, Ammunition, accoutrements and all personal kit will be dealt with as laid down in Field Service Regulations, Part 2, Section 90 (3)

(9) In the case of the Australian and New Zealand Forces the A.A.G. 3rd. Echelon, and the Base Commandant will forward parcels and packages to the Commandant, Training Camp, Australian and New Zealand Forces, Cairo, and not to Messrs Cox and Coy.

DRESS - STAFF

With reference to the second sub-paragraph of paragraph 2, Field Service Regulations, Part 2, Section 14 :- The wearing of red gorget patches or other Staff distinctions, is forbidden except for the following :-

- General Officers and Staff Officer of the General Headquarters Staff of the Force.
- Brigadier General of the General Staff.
- Deputy Adjutant and Quartermaster General Officers of the General Staff.
- Assistant Adjutant General
- Assistant Adjutant and Quartermaster General
- Assistant Quartermaster General
- Deputy Assistant Adjutant General
- Deputy Assistant Quartermaster General
- Deputy Assistant Adjutant and Quartermaster General
- Brigade Major
- Staff Captain; but not Staff Captain R.A.
- Aide- de- Camp.

SCALE OF RATIONS

The scale of rations on disembarkation after leaving Egypt will be :-

- 1 1/4 lbs fresh meat or 1 lb (nominal) preserved meat.
 - 1 1/4 lbs bread or 1 lb biscuit or 1 lb flour.
 - 4 ozs. bacon
 - 3 ozs. cheese
 - 2 ozs peas or beans or dried potatoes
 - 5/8 oz tea
 - 1/4 lb jam
 - 3 ozs sugar
 - 3/8 oz salt
 - 1/20 oz mustard
 - 1/36 oz pepper
 - 1/10 gill (1/320 gall) lime juice
 - 3/8 gill (1/64 gall) rum
 - Tobacco, not exceeding 2 ozs per week, for those who smoke
-) At the direction of the G.O.
) C. on the recommendation of the Medical Officer

Fresh vegetables, whenever obtainable, will be issued at the rate of 3/8 lb per ration and when these are supplied peas, beans or dried potatoes, and lime juice will not be required.
