

ADMINISTRATION.(1).- WATER.

It is the intention to place tanks in Sanitary Areas from which specified Areas will draw.. These tanks will be ~~labeled~~ labelled. The Officer Commanding the Area in which the tank is situated must immediately place a Water Guard over this tank, with definite instructions regarding the care to be taken in issuing the water from same. The Guard on each tank should not be less than 1 N.C.O. and 1 man. This Guard in the case of Areas 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 will assist in the filling of the tanks from the Water Carts which come from the Beach. The remaining Areas will be responsible for the filling of their own tanks from the wells. This water must be boiled or chemically treated. When however, transport is available, water will be brought from the beach for Area No. 6.

(2).- TEMPORARY APPOINTMENT.

That portion of D.O. 206 referring to the appointment of Major F. Ferguson is cancelled and the following is to be substituted :-

Major F. Ferguson, R.E. is temporarily appointed Staff Officer for Engineer Services to No. 3 Section of Defence.
