

Waituna

- *One of the largest wetlands in Aotearoa/NZ
- *Located near Awarua in Murihiku
- *One of the best remaining examples of a natural coastal hapua/lagoon
- *The hāpua is home to a wide range of fish, bird and plant species

Te Nohoka a Tukiauau

- *A hapua/lagoon located on the Taiari/Taieri Plains
- *It was an important mahika kai source for the people of Ōtākou
- *It is part of Sinclair Wetlands
- *The hapua was returned to Ngai Tahu in 1998

Te Waihora

- *It is one of NZ's most polluted lakes
- *It is the largest roto/lake in Te Waipounamu/South Island
- *The restoration project 'Whakaora te Waihora' started in 2011
- *It is known for its patiki/flounder and tuna/eel

Tutaepatu

- *A hāpua/lagoon on the coastline north of Ōtautahi-Christchurch
- *Tuna was one of the principle kailfood gathered there
- *Declared a Wildlief Reserve in 1973
- *The hapua is part of Tūhaitara Coastal Park
