It would be great if you could even book for term three now to make sure you can get times and spaces you would like to meet the learning needs of your class.

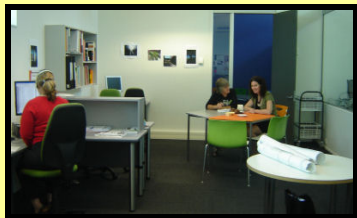
## We're back home!

Discover the skills for finding information on the internet. Have fun looking for interesting information on Tuesday 1 May at all Learning Centres. 6.00pm to 7.30pm.

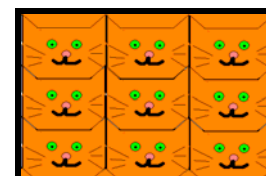
